- Class Format Concern was expressed over alternative ways of teaching some of our courses. Issues discussed were as follows:
 - * Trying to migrate to one of these methods could present a problem in the timing of lab content; i.e. Microbiology. The concern is that process was not followed. Chairs are not always academically qualified for all of their subject areas to understand the implications of these decisions.

* A second issue is a Learning Community that is using a developmental course as one of its course pairings. Banner does not allow this event, so Don Weasenforth has been asked to report how 23 students were able to register under these conditions. How was it determined that students met the prerequisite criteria?
