### **Discussion Items**

- Nomination of PLA Review Board Chair

  - Director Donna Smith volunteered for the chair position.

### • PLA Informational Report

## • Update on Revised Forms and Process

- Forms that students would use to petition for PLA credit are currently being revised. Additionally, Dr. Hardesty has been working on the form that the actual departments would use when developing the plan with the student.
  - Both forms are about ready to go, but they still need to be reviewed by the departments and then compared to each other to make sure the information provided is consistent.
    - We are currently looking at ways to automate the Department Plan Form (i.e. the PLA Advising Plan Sheet) by moving it online.

## • Revised PLA Review Board Operating Guidelines

- Under Section IV. Duties:
  - Chair Elect:
    - Assumes the Chair position after the summer meeting.
- Under Section V. Meetings:
  - a. Meeting Dates. The Review Board will meet a minimum of three (3) times during the academic year (Fall, Spring, Summer). The next PLA Review Board meeting should be scheduled at the close of each meeting, however, meetings can be called when necessary.
- A repository is available on the I-Drive for all the PLA documentation.
  - A general list of the approved PLA opportunities is listed on Collin's website, but for specific and active PLA course options, internal reports are used.
    - This will be added to the I-Drive.

# • Institutional Credit by Exam

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- On the Testing Center form, there's a section for Institutional Credit by Exam. Are we familiar with which exams are offered and should we be finding PLA members who are willing to reach out to them?
  - The only tests that are still being administered through the Testing Center are the Fire Safety exams (six tests in total). Karen Stewart will reach out to the Fire Safety staff to confirm if exams are still offered and which ones they are.

# • CAB Chair Liaison Report – Donna Smith

- There were no CAB updates at the time of the PLA Review Board meeting.
  - Discussion: How can PLA be promoted at Collin in different areas such as CAB?
    - For new programs, ask the proposer(s) if students may already be coming into the program with industry certifications and/or prior work experience.
      - Questions regarding changes to PLA options are included on

CAB proposal documents.

- Maintain an up-to-date linked course list on the website.
- Inform general academic advisors of ways to identify students who may be PLA candidates and provide contact information to the student on which academic department can assist them further.
  - Information on PLA will be presented to Student and Enrollment Services once the PLA forms and processes are finalized.
- Career coaches can flag students who may be PLA candidates for programs that require departmental registration.
- Include mention of possible PLA opportunities in program orientations.
- Include general information on PLA in Collin's new student orientation.
