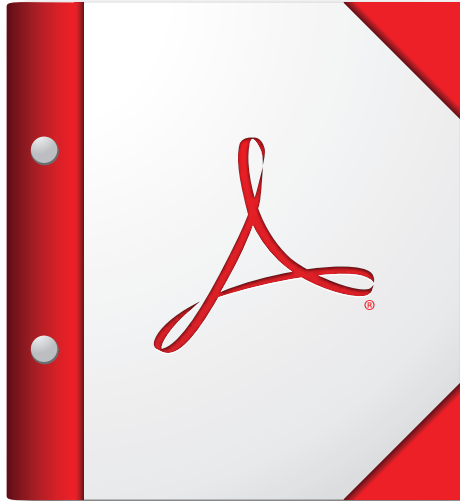
CAB Business

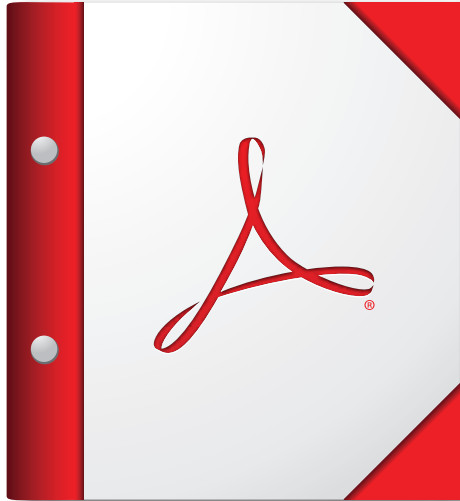
