## AY 2015 COURSE ENROLLMENT BY TYPE

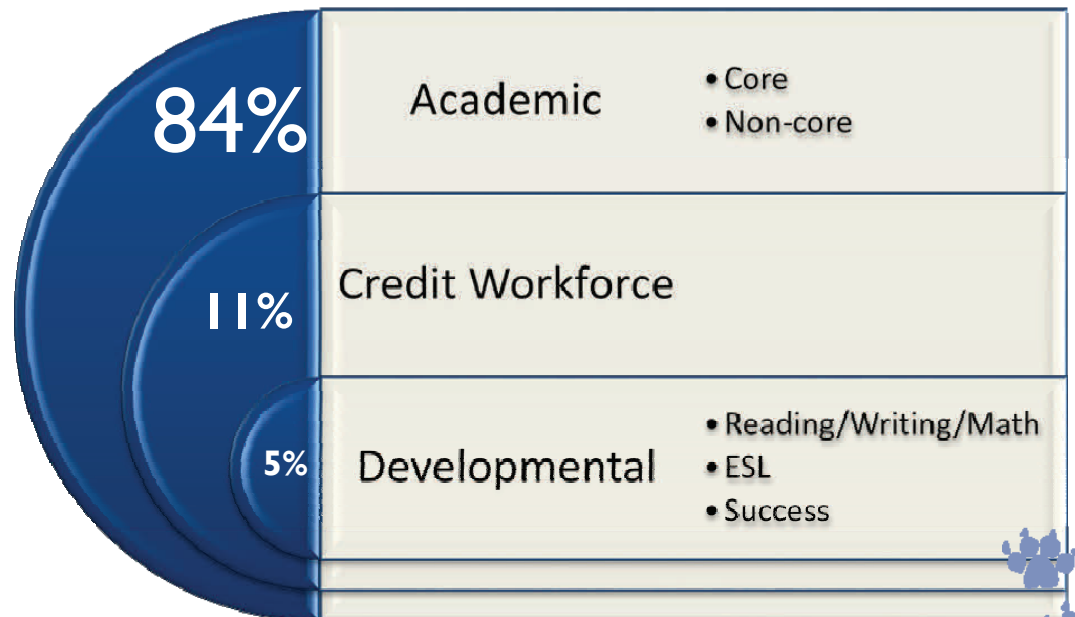

Workforce enrollment has consistently been 11% since AY 2006. Developmental enrollment had been approximately 9% until the recent changes in the Texas Success Initiative regulations. The four percent reduction in Developmental course enrollment all migrated to Academic Transfer coursework.



Five core courses accounted for 23% of the total AY 2015 enrollment, and 28% of Academic Transfer enrollment. All of these courses are required for degree completion.
