
SPOTLIGHT ON COMPLETION



This month's curriculum spotlight is on student progress toward degree or certificate completion. A sample of 400 first-time full-time (FTFT) students who enrolled at Collin College in fall 2014 are being tracked for four years to see how they earn credits toward their declared educational credential.


AY2015 Sample of 400 FTFT Students
