Below are the enrollment figures for Collin College programs that started in fall of 2017 and fall of 2018. 🐾

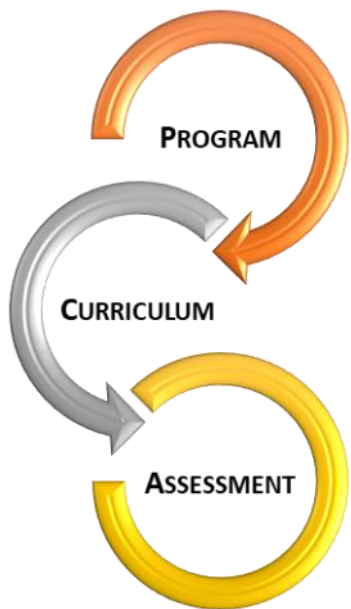
