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## Using Canvas Studio – Part 1 (60 minutes)

Canvas Studio allows faculty to upload videos directly into Canvas, without taking up vital storage space in their courses. This webinar will cover the basics of Canvas Studio and its use. By the end of this webinar participants will be able to: access Studio at the Global and Course levels, upload an mp4 to Studio, add captions to a Studio video, organize videos with Collections within Studio, pull in videos from YouTube to Studio, share/embed Canvas Studio Videos with students.

## Using Canvas Studio – Part 2 (60 minutes)

Canvas Studio has the potential to greatly enhance the usefulness of video content in a Canvas course. This webinar will cover advanced features of Canvas Studio. By the end of this webinar participants will be able to: record screen capture videos in Studio using Screencast-o-Matic, edit videos created in Studio using the video editor in Screencast-o-Matic, create quizzes for Canvas Studio videos, share/embed Studio videos with a quiz, post Studio quiz scores to the Gradebook.
