

# SCULPT for Accessibility

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## **About**

- The six basic elements of making content accessible
- SCULPT: Structure, Color contrast, Use of images, Links, Plain English, Table Structure

## **Structure:**

- Use built-in heading styles
- Allows those with visual impairments to navigate document

## **Colour Contrast**

- Use a strong colour contrast between text and background
- Allows those with visual impairments to perceive the content

## **Use of Images**

- Use alt text to describe the image
- Allows those with visual impairments to read the visual

## **Links**

- Name hyperlinks clearly and accurately
- Allows those with visual impairments to know which websites to access

## **Plain English**

- Write with the audience in mind
- Allows those with limited English proficiency or cognitive disabilities to understand the content

## **Table Structure**

- Use a simple table structure
- Allows those with visual impairments to read the table with a screenreader
