

CLEP (College Level Examination Program)

The Registrar's Office certifies credit earned on a CLEP Subject Examination. As of July 1, 2001, the passing score for each CLEP exam is 50. The passing score of 50 does not apply to, or affect any, CLEP exams taken before July 1, 2001. CLEP exams are given by appointment only. For an appointment call the Spring Creek Campus at 972.881.5922.

A student does not have to be currently enrolled at CCCCD to take these exams.

Listed below are the CLEP Subject Examinations in which a student may receive credit at CCCCD. The fee is \$50 payable by check, credit card, or money order to CLEP for each examination. There is also a \$15 test administration fee to be paid to CCCCD before a student may take a CLEP test. Examinations are, typically, 90-minute multiple choice objective tests, except for the English examination which has an additional 90-minute essay requirement.

Students must contact the institution they are planning to attend for its requirements regarding CLEP.

The Subject Examination in Freshman College Composition also has a 90-minute essay section, which is required by some colleges. Students must check with the institution that they are planning to attend for its requirements. CCCCD requires the essay section. If the essay section is attempted, the score will be weighted as follows:

Essay section: 70 percent
Multiple-choice section: 30 percent

The CLEP Code Number for CCCCD is 1951.

Note: Students must contact the Director of Testing in order to receive credit for any CLEP, Advanced Placement Examination or departmental exam.
