Your 1098T Tuition Payment Statement will be mailed to your permanent address on or before January 30. Please allow 1 to 2 weeks for delivery. The 1098T reflects the billed amount on your student account in 2003. For a breakdown of the tuition and fees, access your individual account by logging into student services. You will need your student ID and pin number. For explanations of the requirements for (and how to figure) any allowable tuition deduction or education credit, see IRS Pub 970. Collin County Community College District cannot determine the taxpayer's eligibility for the tax credit, therefore, if you need further assistance you should contact a professional tax advisor.

Warning: The Webline service has a 15 minute time-out feature. After 15 minutes of inactivity your session will be terminated.

Warning: Do Not **DOUBLE CLICK** on links or use the **Back** and **Forward** buttons when using Webline. Doing so will terminate your session. Links are located on each page to navigate you through the system.

Warning: After **Payment DeadLine** for each semester you must pay in full for all registration activity **each day**. An unpaid balance at the end of the day will cause you to be dropped from all classes you registered for on that day, **regardless of any payment made**.

For example:

- 9:00 AM you register for 9 hours and pay in full with Credit Card.
- 10:30 AM you register for 3 more hours and **do not** pay for these hours.
- Result: you will be dropped from all 12 hours.

Grades will no longer be mailed out to the general student population. Students may access their grades electronically by clicking on Login to Student Services below or via the telephone at 469-452-2222 (Collin County) or 469-757-2222 (Rockwall Area). Students will need their social security numbers and their PIN numbers to access either system. Anyone needing a paper transcript for any reason, work reimbursement or scholarship continuation for example, can come to the Admissions Office on any campus and one will be printed for them free of charge.
