Paul Grossman, J.D.

With over 40 years of experience as a Chief Civil Rights Attorney for the US Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), Paul Grossman, J.D. has litigated and negotiated nearly every kind of civil rights matter pertinent to education. An important element of Paul's presentation will focus on the lessons that he has learned from teaching disability law for over 20 years at the Hastings College of Law, University of California. With classes predominately attended by individuals with disabilities, Paul has had to develop and test many new forms of accommodation. Consistent with the concept of "universal design in curriculum and instruction," Paul has identified modifications that are of benefit to all his students, while simultaneously serving to remove the stigma usually associated with accommodating students with disabilities.

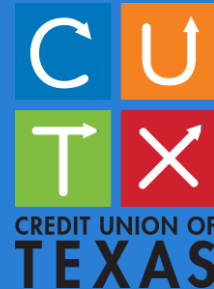
