• Approve January 11th meeting minutes

- January meeting minutes reviewed and approved as written.
- Review and discuss proposed changes to Personal Responsibility rubric.
 - We want students to understand ethical issues. In the past, when we have used the personal responsibility rubric, there has been a lot of discussion on assessment days and confusion about just how to go about distinguishing between choices and actions.
 - The first change that we are proposing is to collapse understanding choices and actions into one row.
 - Also introducing a new row titled Understanding Ethical Issues.
 - Can they outline the ethical issues and any consequences? Previous rubric might have been confusing for the students. Some rewording that may be needed.
 - This will clear up some of the confusion that we have been encountering on assessment days with this personal responsibility rubric.
 - April meeting vote to accept changes or keep the original rubric.
