

Tips for Unpacking the COAT Rubrics

Performance Levels	Clarification
1 = Does Not Meet Expectations	 The student shows no knowledge or understanding of the topic The student writes about the topic using irrelevant or inaccurate information The student recalls the information, steps, process, with no understanding of how the directions, activity and/or task relate to the topic
2 = Partially Meets Expectations	 The student partially understands the topic, directions, activity and/or task The student includes a few important ideas, elements, or components The student's response includes a few supporting facts or examples of the important relationships, processes, or procedures The response is not well organized or lacks clarity
3 = Meets Expectations	 The student is knowledgeable about the topic The student includes several of the important ideas, elements or components The student's response includes several supporting facts or examples that demonstrate full understanding of the important relationships, processes, or procedures The student's response connects the major concepts/principles or ideas The student's response mostly includes one perspective or point of view The response is good, has some detail, and is clear
4 = Exceeds Expectations	 The student is highly knowledgeable about the topic The student includes many of the important ideas, elements, and/or components The student's response includes many specific facts or examples that show an in-depth understanding of the important relationships, processes, or procedures The student's response is organized around the major concepts/principles or ideas The student's response includes multiple, well-balanced perspectives or points of view The response is exemplary, detailed, and clear
