



Core Objective Informational Rubric: Communication Skills

There are six core objectives in the Texas Core Curriculum.

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board has defined the core objective of “Communication Skills” as effective development, interpretation, and expression of ideas through written, oral, and visual communication

CRITERIA USED IN ASSESSMENT

Development

The student organizes content in support of a central idea

Expression

The student shows appropriate awareness of an intended audience, adjusting the subject matter, syntax, and mechanics of the product

Interpretation

The student uses relevant content that conveys understanding of the subject matter
