CRITERIA USED IN ASSESSMENT

Understanding ethical issues

Ethical issues are those that involve moral values or principles; concepts or right and wrong

Understanding choices and actions

Choices and actions are defined as the possible responses to an ethical issue

Understanding consequences

Consequences are defined as the result or outcome of making a choice and/or taking action
