CRITERIA USED IN ASSESSMENT

Understanding the Characteristics of Communities and/or Cultures

Understanding that different communities and/or cultures may have different perspectives, beliefs, traditions, or needs.

Recognizing Principles of Social or Civic Responsibility

Recognition that societal issues can affect communities and/or cultures.

Addressing Influence of Social Principles

Addressing how social elements influence behavior and decision making.

Impact of Social Engagement

Recognition of the impact personal/social actions have on communities and/or cultures.
