Understanding the Characteristics of Communities and/or Cultures Community or culture is defined as any group of people with similar backgrounds or interests. Addressing Influence of Social Principles "Social elements" can include, but are not limited to: history, religious beliefs, politics, communication style, economy, etc.	Makes no attempt to address how social elements influence behavior and decision making.	Begins to address how social elements influence behavior and decision making.	Adequately addresses how social elements influence behavior and decision making.	Thoroughly addresses how social elements influence behavior and decision making.
Impact of Social Engagement	Does not recognize the impact of personal/social actions on communities and/or cultures. Thoroughly recognizes the impact of personal/social actions on-communities and/or cultures showing deep understanding.
