 - Idea: Team-based learning (Kandice Swarthout- recommended by Cathleen Akers)
 - o Idea: Mental Health
 - o Idea: Management Disruptive Students in DC Classrooms
 - o Idea: Dual Credit in general
 - o Idea: Access Office
 - o Idea: Split Session- techniques to prevent issues / admin side of an issue
 - Suggested Names: Rachel Mueller (DC issues), Courtney Mulcahy (Canvas 101), Rachel B Walker/Alaya Swann/Clair Robertson (Lesson Plans 101), Erika Nielson Vargas (mental health and mindfulness), Emily Suh (Students with ADHD)
 - o Faculty Council has an Adjunct Committee- difficult to get a wide variety of feedback from adjuncts

- o Cathleen asked about data from recorded session videos that have been watched
- John Hoenig- suggested that we do not record a FAQ roundtable/panel at the
 Adjunct Faculty Conference
- Spring Faculty Development Conference: Today is the last day for proposals- 35 proposals received so far
 - o All call for proposals will be sent to the FDAC members (without names), and we will be asked to rank them all
 - Next time we meet we will make final decisions on who is accepted and who is not
 - o Next Meeting: 3 weeks from now so plenty of time to review them
- Faculty Development Fall 2026 Conference
- Courtenay: created speaker chart based on feedback and previous ideas
 - o Four listed: James Lang, Veronica Yan, Jovan Glasgow, Jose Antonio Bowen
 - o Courtenay: Jovan Glasgow- more motivational speaker
 - o Three votes for Bowen, a few votes for Yan
 - Ask for a clarification on Small Teaching- small things you can do in your class to integrate change
 - Bill Nye the Science Guy- recommended by Russell Smith / never mind he is
 \$70K
 - o Courtenay Jauregui: provided links to videos of their talks
 - o Cathleen Akers: would prefer that we not go with the motivational speaker (Jovan Glasgow)
 - o Veronica Yan fits the category of motivating students the most
 - o Courtenay: they were all good, but Glasgow was a bit different than the other ones
- Allison: is "student motivation" a topic that we are hearing about a lot / themes in other committees?
 - o John said Magna Pubs is encouraging discussion about student motivation
 - o Cathleen Akers: general observation about students going through the motions / is this a covid-era holdover? / Would Veronica Yan give us insight into how students brains are working?
 - o Veronica Yan is an educational psychologist- can cover mindset, motivation, and metacognition

- o How do we book speakers? Price, availability, and specific topics, but we don't get to choose their specific transcript but give them parameters that we would like.
- o Committee: coalescing around Veronica Yan- T&D will reach out to her and see if she is available
- o Allison: If you hear about other speakers, please let me know.
