As all members agreed that Canvas would be perfect for the Virtual HSS event, Kimberly offered to make some changes such as changing the Homepage, to the existing Canvas course to make it suitable for the event.

Robert felt a 2<sup>nd</sup> Canvas shell dedicated to the Virtual HSS event, Marlo indicated that 2 shells may not be given to the HSS committee.

Kimberly will get in touch with Andrew about conducting a Zoom session live on Canvas.

The Canvas shell will go live on April 9<sup>th</sup>, a week ahead of the Virtual HSS event on April 16<sup>th</sup>, so students can watch the videos.

Kimberly will reach out to web services and explore the possibility of a 2<sup>nd</sup> Canvas shell with self-enroll option for the Virtual HSS event. The next meeting will be decided once Kimberly hears from the web services.
