- I. Chief Scott Jenkins
 - a. Handgun Policies & Practices
 - Chief referenced Board policy CHF (local) as guiding policy for the committee and foundation for district policies and practices.
 - 3 arrests for handguns in prohibited areas.
 - Reference to a weapon during a fight between employees @ Plano.
 - Airsoft guns were used on the McKinney Campus.
 - Threats of guns in student housing (hearsay)
 - FBI contacted us re a social media threat of a weapon on campus. Found to be a hoax.
 - b. Camera System Successes
 - Multiple uses helped in resolving cases of destruction, burglary, family violence, etc
 - c. Cellular Project
 - Chief provided updated history and status of the current Ericsson cellular DOT system at the Technical campus. It is going to be applied across the district.

The question raised re: whether the cellular DOT could be tied to a generator in case of a power outage. BK to follow up with Shane.

- d. School Marshal Update
 - The next cohort (3rd) is in May.
 - 1st cohort goes through retraining soon (conducted every two years).
