## **Curriculum Proposals**

- Computer-Aided Drafting and Design
  - o CNBT courses are not providing needing preparation for students, replacing with CADD coursework-specific courses
  - Removing the second certificate level 1 and adding a certificate level 2
    - Certificates are stackable
  - Students currently in the program are able to take the courses that have been removed – old track will be available for two years
  - Need to correct pre/concurrent requirement of DFTG 1309 on AAS for DFTG 2328
  - Dr. Smith motioned to approve. Dr. Leverette seconded. Unanimous approval.
- Construction Technology Plumbing
  - Removing CNBT course and replacing with plumbing-specific course
    - Change made in AAS, certificate level 1, and certificate level 2
  - o Dr. Mesch motioned to approve. Dr. McRae seconded. Unanimous approval.
- Criminal Justice
  - Adjusting for new Texas Transfer Framework
    - Following State's recommended course of study
    - Adding CRIJ 1301 as a core course
      - Concerns expressed over offering it as a core course
    - · Aligned with the 60-hour degree
  - o Dr. Smith motioned to approve. Dr. Mensch seconded. 19 voted aye. 1 voted nay due to concerns over CRIJ 1301 as a core course. Motion carried.
- Engineering-
  - Adding a one-hour lab to two courses
    - ACGM allows for purposes of practical experience within classwork
    - Does not affect credit hours, only contact hours
    - Gives students opportunities for more hands-on work with professor assistance

- Replaced PHYS 2425 with PHYS 2426 as a prerequisite to electrical circuits courses due to requirements by ACGM
- o Dr. Mesch motioned to approve. Dr. McRae seconded. Unanimous approval.
- Geospatial Information Science
  - o Adding pertinent courses
  - o Rearranging courses to better utilize each semester
  - o Adjusted prerequisites to ensure students are prepared for the program
  - o Adding a certificate level 2
  - o Students currently in the program are able to take the courses that have been removed old track will be available until they complete
  - o Dr. Smith motioned to approve. Dr. McRae seconded. Unanimous approval.
