Curriculum Proposals

- Sport and Recreation Management
 - Added FITT 1380 and removed BMGT 2382 to provide a specific sports management course rather than a generic business course (both are co-op courses).
 - Able to be taught by Sports and Recreation faculty.
 - Opened up electives, while still recommending specific math and economic courses.
 - ~50 students in the program each year, no completers for the last two years.
 - Will courses transfer?
 - Working with UNT to try to ensure courses will transfer. 2+2 possibility?
 - Courses are more WECM-based rather than transferable.
 - Are there job possibilities for students who graduate with this degree?
 - Perhaps revisit this program and get a presentation on this program to learn about goals and future plans in December.
 - Dr. Mark Smith motioned to approve this proposal and revisit the program as a whole in December. Dr. Mary McRae seconded this proposal. Unanimous approval.
