Recommendation discussion (list all new programs or program changes discussed):

New Programs Review

- AS – Engineering FOS
 - Civil Engineering FOS
 - Adding option to take either Gen Ed Creative Arts component or Social & Behavioral Sciences component (instead of only creative arts)
 - Mechanical Engineering FOS
 - Adding option to take either Gen Ed Creative Arts component or Social & Behavioral Sciences component (instead of only creative arts)
 - Changes help align the AS – FOS curriculum for transfer agreement with 4-year institutions that require Social & Behavioral Science component as part of the course transfer block
 - Component option does not significantly impact course enrollment, thus involvement from other disciplines is not necessary
 - Dr. McRae motioned to approve. Dr. King seconded. Unanimous approval.

- Interior Design
