Curriculum Proposals

- **Robotics and Automation Technology**
 - Removed CETT 1445, Microprocessor from being a requirement and added it as an elective
 - Added ELMT 2480, which is a coop class with occupational experience opportunities, as an elective
 - Added MATH 1316 or higher-level math to prerequisites for CETT 1409 and ELMT 1305 to be consistent with other programs
 - Removed requirement of consent of Associate Dean/Director for CEET 1307 due to addition of higher-level math option to prerequisites
 - Questions arose regarding what courses might qualify as higher-level
 - Dr. Mesch motioned to approve. Dr. McRae seconded. Unanimous approval.
- **Electronic Engineering Technology**
 - Added MATH 1316 or higher-level math to prerequisites for CETT 1307 and CEET 1409 to be consistent with other programs
 - Removed requirement of consent of Associate Dean/Director for CEET 1307 due to addition of higher-level math option to prerequisites
 - Restructured certificate level 1 to be a one-year program
 - Added a certificate level 2 program
 - Confirmed that coop opportunity is available for all programs
 - Dr. Corwin motioned to approve. Dr. Mesch seconded. Unanimous approval.
