Recommendation discussion (list all new programs or program changes discussed):

Curriculum Proposals – New Programs

- **AAS in Information Assurance and Certificate Level 1**
 - Multiple local needs courses embedded in the program.
 - Feeds into the BAT.
 - Aligned on policy and business, providing a secondary pathway into the information assurance - cybersecurity sector.
 - Associated certificate is comprised of the non-core courses.
 - All courses are available online, allowing for students to qualify for the BAT through a fully-online program format.
 - A prospectus will be required once the program is approved internally. Fall 2024 is the intended start date if approved.
 - Request for more feedback for students using this program to get into the BAT – want to ensure they have the needed technical skills to succeed. Suggestion to approve and then increase technical aspects.
 - Dr. Lee motioned to approve. Dr. Leverette seconded. Unanimous approval.
- **Medical Massage Therapy Certificate Level 1**
 - Request from the community for additional sources for employees.
 - Nationwide-need for medical skill for massage therapists.
 - Clinical work will be done at local massage locations.
 - Curriculum follows what is required for certification as a massage therapist.
 - Dr. Smith motioned to approve. Dr. Corwin seconded. Unanimous approval.


