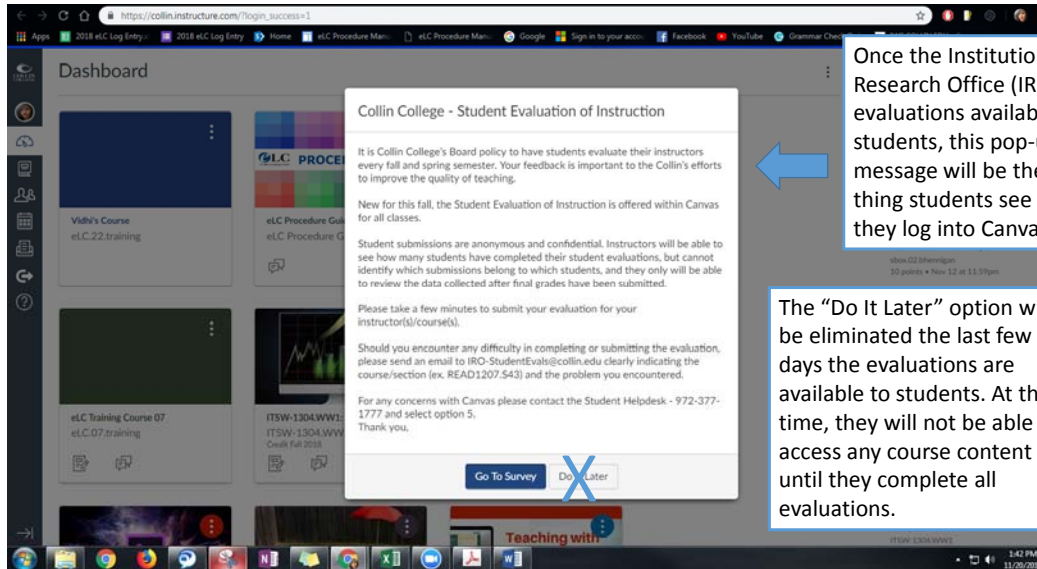


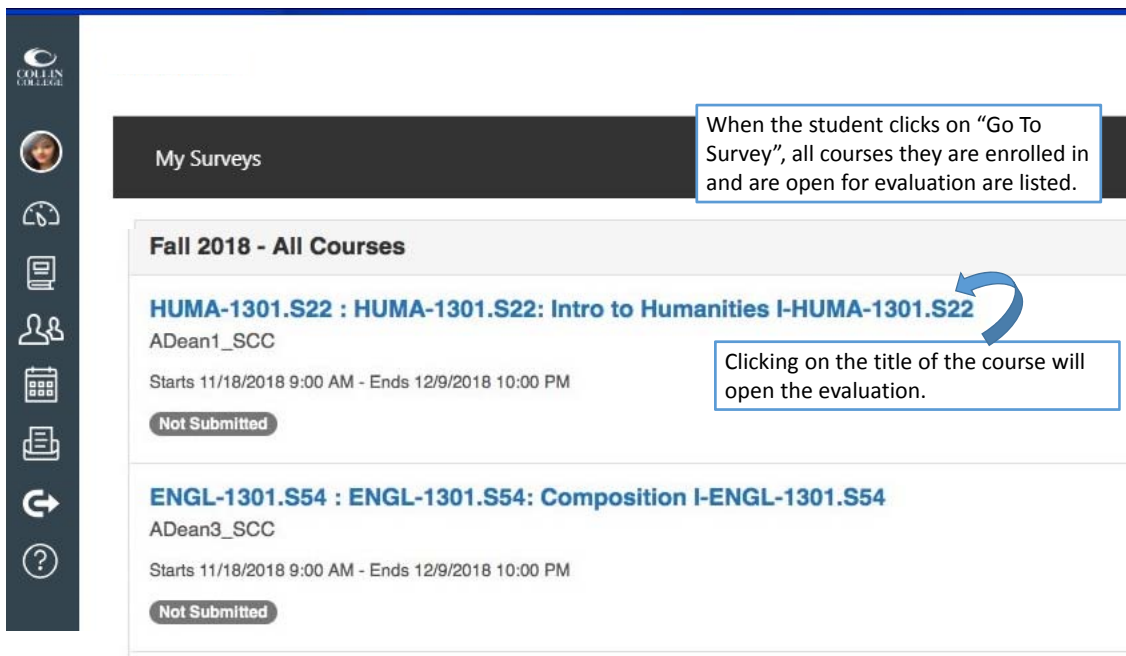


# Students Evaluations in Canvas



Once the Institutional Research Office (IRO) makes evaluations available to students, this pop-up message will be the first thing students see when they log into Canvas

The "Do It Later" option will be eliminated the last few days the evaluations are available to students. At that time, they will not be able to access any course content until they complete all evaluations.



When the student clicks on "Go To Survey", all courses they are enrolled in and are open for evaluation are listed.

Clicking on the title of the course will open the evaluation.
