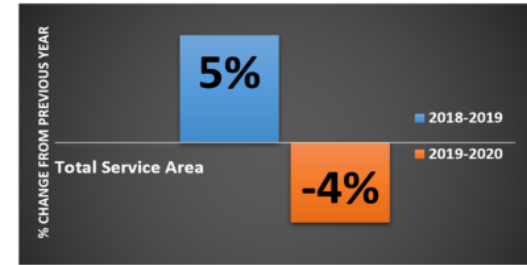


Figure 1. Percentage change in immediate enrollment at Collin from service area high schools: 2018-2019 vs. 2019-2020

IMPACT OF PANDEMIC? Immediate enrollment at Collin (Summer/Fall 2020) from its service area high schools' graduating class of 2020 declined to 4,024 from 4,182 graduates in 2019; a 4% decrease (Figure 1). This is in contrast to a 5% increase in fall 2019 when more graduates enrolled at Collin compared to 2018 (4,182 vs. 3,980). In light of research, the decline in Summer/Fall 2020 enrollment is most likely due to the impact of COVID-19.

A report released by the National Student Clearing House Research Center (NSCHRC) on December 10, 2020 estimates the impact of COVID-19 on: (a) the number of high school graduates for 2019-2020 and (b) the immediate postsecondary enrollment of the graduating class of 2020. Based on data from 2,324 high schools across US, a key preliminary finding is that **22% fewer graduates went to college immediately compared to the class of 2019. The immediate college enrollment declined across all institution types, however, the decline was highest for Community Colleges (-30%)** Findings from the NSCHRC also indicate that the pandemic had greater impact on immediate enrollment of graduates from high poverty, low income and urban high schools (NSCHRC, 2020).

Other studies also document the impact of the pandemic on immediate college enrollment. A survey of 1,000 US teens shows that 57% were concerned about their future plans and 30% said their expected college start date had changed (Wakefield, 2020). Another national survey of 487 prospective college students (Art & Science Group, 2020) indicates that 17% believed they would not be attending college in fall 2020 and of those 35% planned to take a gap year. Thirty-one percent of students cancelled their early start programs. One in six 4-year prospective students appeared to be giving up on the idea of attending a 4-year institution (StudentPoll, March 2020). In Texas, only 24% of high school seniors filled out FAFSA forms; a decline of 15% from same time last year (McGee 2020). A national snapshot survey of 2,000 enrolled college students in spring 2020 indicated that 10% were unsure of their fall re-enrollment plans (American Council on Education, 2020).

The NSCHRC data for 2,324 high schools shows that 2019-2020 graduation was unaffected by COVID-19 as the number of graduates remained fairly stable. A similar pattern is observed for Collin's service area high schools — the number of graduates was not affected. Rather graduates were up from 17,838 in 2019 to 18,412 in 2020, a 4% increase. However, the graduating class of 2020's immediate enrollment at Collin declined from 4,182 graduates in 2019 to 4,024 in 2020; a decrease of 4%. In the light of NSCHRC data for community colleges, Collin appears to be doing comparatively well in the pandemic.

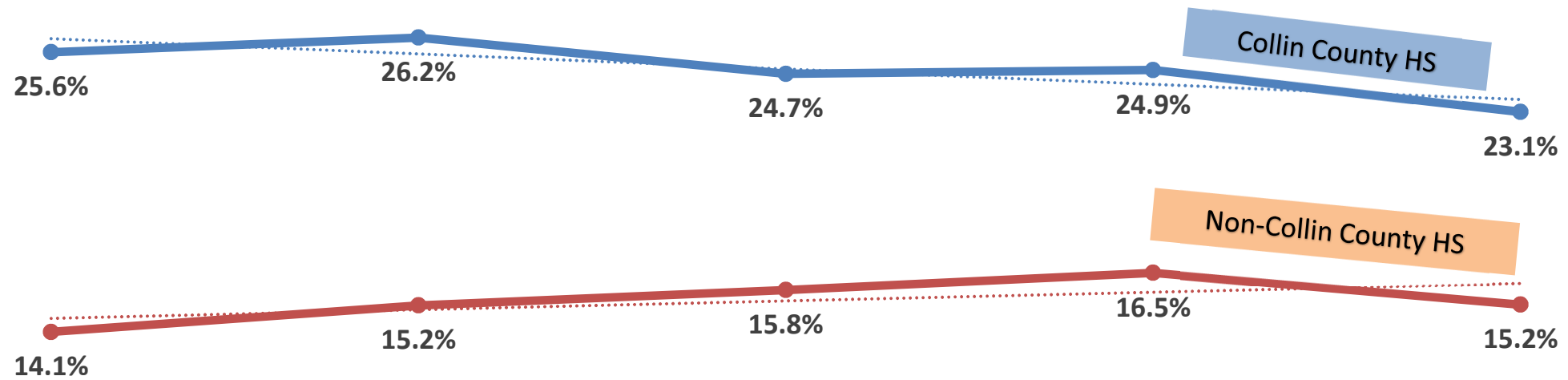

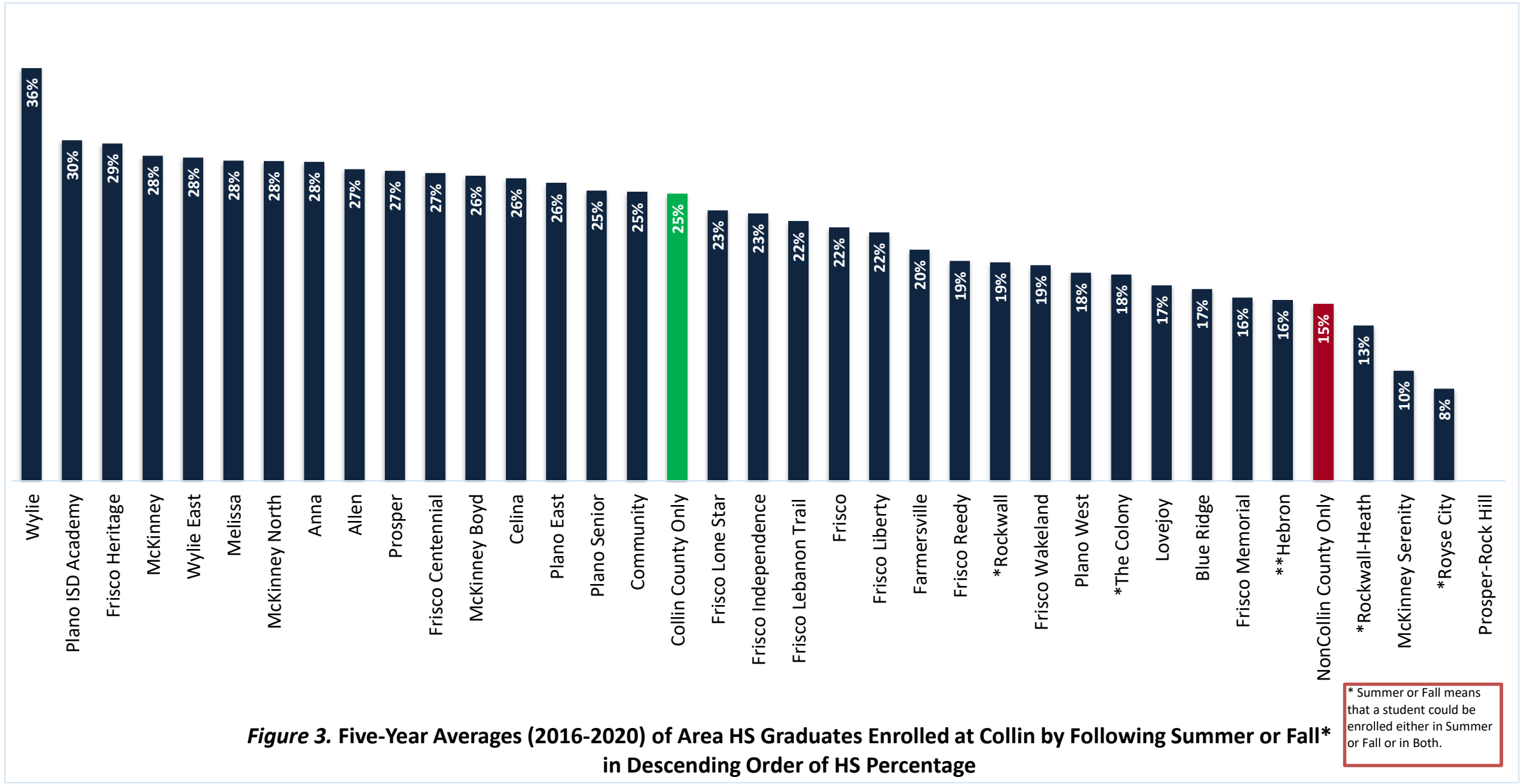
