**An "adjusted cohort" consists of the group of all first-time-in-college, full-time, degree-seeking students--minus any exclusions (e.g., student deaths)--enrolled during fall 2017 for baccalaureate-granting institutions (Austin, Collin, Dallas, Lone Star, San Jacinto, and South Texas) or fall 2020 for non-baccalaureate-granting institutions (Alamo, El Paso, Houston, and Tarrant County). Students in the adjusted cohorts were monitored by each institution to determine their status at the end of 150% of the time required for normal program completion.
