**"Adjusted cohort" consists of the group of all first-time-in-college, full-time, degree-seeking students enrolled during fall 2015 for baccalaureate-granting institutions (Austin, Collin, Dallas, Lone Star, San Jacinto, and South Texas) or fall 2018 for non-baccalaureate-granting institutions (Alamo, El Paso, Houston, and Tarrant County) adjusted for any exclusions. Students in the adjusted cohorts were monitored by each institution to determine their status at the end of 150% of the time required for normal program completion.
